07 May 8.25miles, 13km; 1200ft, 370m

3C Moorland tracks and riverside path via Grange Scar, Little Asby Scar, top of the Potts Beck and back via the valley. A few stiles

- 14 May 5.5miles, 9km; 1000ft, 300m
- 3C Moorland with one steep but steady climb

Linear walk from Aira Force to Pooley Bridge

- THU ULLSWATER WAY
- 16 May 13miles, 21km; 600ft, 180m
- 4D A scenic section from Aira Force to Pooley Bridge, easy walking on west of lake, undulating on the east

TUE BLACK CRAG AND HOLME FELL

- 21 May 7miles, 11km; 2000ft, 610m
- 3C Tarn Hows, Black Crag, Hodge Close, Holme Fell. Good fell paths

THU CAUSEY PIKE

WED

- 23 May 8miles, 12.3km; 2700ft, 820m
- 1B Causey Pike, Scar Crags, Sail Pass, Ard Crags, Knott Rigg, Keskadale, Newlands Church and back to Chapel Bridge.

Leisurely linear walk. Option of going up Gowbarrow PATTERDALE TO AIRA FORCE 0

- 29 May 4miles, 6km; 500ft, 150m
- 5D A leisurely stroll along the Ullswater way with the option of lunch, a sail back to Glenridding or bus back to Patterdale

THU BLENCATHRA FROM MUNGRISDALE

- 30 May 10miles, 16km; 3100ft, 940m
- Up Souther Fell then traverse to Blencathra summit via Scales Tarn (possible swim) Option to do Sharp Edge. Down Foule Crag to Bannerdale Crags and Bowscale Fell. Descend south side of the Tongue. Good fell paths but steep ascents and descents.

WED SHAP ABBEY TO KNIPE SCAR

- 05 Jun 11 miles, 18km; 1200ft, 370m
- 3C Field paths, tracks and minor road, good views and quiet area

THU WILD BOAR FELL AND SWARTH FELL

- 06 Jun 13miles, 21km; 2300ft, 700m
- 2C Fell paths, some off path. Return via Hellgill, Thrang and River Eden

TUE AN HISTORIC HIKE THROUGH GREAT ASBY AND BEYOND

11 Jun 11 miles, 18km; 1000ft, 300m
3D A low level walk along farm tracks and through fields taking in an ancient site, limekiln, pate hole, limestone pavement and Nature Reserve

- 25 Jun 5miles, 8km; 500ft, 150m
- 4D Good tracks and river paths

THU WINTON TO GREAT MUSGRAVE

- 27 Jun 10miles, 16km; 700ft, 210m
- 4D A low-level walk passing Brough Castle to the lovely Musgrave Church beside the River Eden. Return mainly along quiet, level lanes and byways.

TUE NAB FROM HARTSOP

- 02 Jul 9miles, 14km; 3200ft, 980m
- Hartsop up to Hayeswater. Steeply up to Rest Dodd then a there and back to The Nab. Satura Crag to Angle tarn. (Swim option). Angle tarn Pikes, Cat Crag to Brock Crags. Then descent to Hartsop. Mostly good fell paths. Steep ascent and descent. Please note the Nab is extremely boggy and full of challenging peat hags. In event of very wet weather we may have to omit it!

- 7.5miles, 12km; 850ft, 260m 08 Aug
- 4D A walk through (but never actually 'on') an area of spectacular limestone pavements. Easy tracks

THU LONSCALE FELL VIA BURNT HORSE AND LATRIGG

10miles, 16km; 2317ft, 710m 15 Aug

Cumbria Way towards Skiddaw House turning left to $2\mathbf{B}$ climb steeply up Burnt Horse then on to Lonscal,e picking up the tourist path then up to Latrigg, with several options for the way down.

11.5miles, 19km: 3600ft, 1100m 20 Aug 1BA strenuous fell walk over Wetherlam, Coniston Old Man and Dow Crag

Linear walk from Cross Keys to Sedbergh CAUTLEY SPOUT AND CRAG. THE CALF

- 1BReturn via White Fell. Crook of Lune. River Lune. Fell paths, some minor road, riverside.
